

Emissions reduction targets

This document contains our first carbon footprint assessment and carbon reduction plan. In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we are tracking our progress against the carbon reduction targets illustrated in the graph below.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the five years from our baseline to 3.8 tCO₂e by 2023. This is a reduction of 35%.



Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been implemented since the 2018 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these initiatives has significantly contributed to the reduction noted in our 2020 emissions reporting against the 2018 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract.

- We have replaced our company car fleet with fully electric vehicles to reduce carbon emissions on both business travel and employee personal travel use
- We encourage employees to avoid unnecessary travel and promote working from home when possible. In addition, we have supported the principle of localisation to ensure employees are deployed to sites within the region they live in, rather than requiring significant travel
- We use virtual office arrangements to avoid the need for regional offices and associated heating and lighting costs when the office accommodation would regularly be vacant
- We use environmentally concerned energy providers to provide our energy requirements.
- We use LED light bulbs and similar energy saving devices
- We are committed to a paperless office, and we produce little to no waste in our business activities

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Build awareness amongst our workforce of the impact of their decisions on our journey to net zero.
- Continue practice as a paperless office
- Further reduce business travel by air, rail and road through effective measurement and a sustainable travel policy.
- Work with employees and suppliers to encourage them to set their own carbon reductions targets in line with Identity E2E's commitment to achieving Net Zero Carbon.
- Actively quantify carbon emissions from commuting and working from home via a rolling employee survey and use this as an opportunity to decrease scope 3 emissions via employee engagement.
